I am pleased to advise you that the above mentioned fire protection district within the province of Ontario was recently registered in the fire insurance grading index as being accredited for the delivery of Superior Tanker Shuttle Service (STSS).

The requirements for this accreditation are stringent and verify that the fire protection district is capable of delivering the minimum accepted fire flows to Commercial Lines insured property throughout the fire protection district and within 5 kilometres by road of the responding fire station. This accreditation is an equivalency using alternative water supply methods to achieve the minimum requirements for hydrant protection status, as set out by the insurance industry and the Fire Underwriters Survey (FUS).

Fire Underwriters Survey has provided information on fire protection and risk levels to the insurance industry in Canada since 1883. Fire Underwriters Survey (FUS) was previously operated under the auspices of the Insurers Advisory Organization (IAO) and SCM- Opta Information Intelligence; however, is now operated by Verisk Analytics.

Public Fire Protection Classification 7 (S) is applicable to Commercial Lines insured property within 5 kilometres of the above noted Fire Station(s), and within 2.5 kilometres by road of a recognised water supply point.
