



MUNICIPALITY OF STRATHROY-CARADOC PARK STREET SEWAGE PUMPING STATION UPGRADES

CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY NOTICE- WELL POINTS

The Municipal Council for Strathroy-Caradoc has awarded the above contract to Stone Town Construction Ltd. for the reconstruction of the Park Street Sewage Pumping Station. The consulting engineers responsible for the design and site inspection are R.V. Anderson Associates Limited. Construction-related activities have begun with the excavation around the pumping station. This is a small reconstruction project includes replacement of the old pumping station and electrical work associated with the operation of the pumping station.

Well Points

In order to facilitate the work that is necessary for this project, we will be required to dewater the construction site. The dewatering system is operating 24 hours a day in order to lower groundwater levels for the excavation. These pumps can also temporarily lower groundwater levels in the surrounding area, affecting the water supply to other sand points or wells that supply water. If you have received this notice, the groundwater level at your property might be affected.

If you use a sand point/well for irrigation or heating/cooling it could become dry during the project. Running your pump without water can destroy it. We recommend that you shut off sand points/wells until dewatering on Park Street has concluded

This is an intrusive construction project that will affect the normal activities of your community. Your cooperation and patience are appreciated.
