Dear Resident:

The firm of Cope Construction & Contracting Inc. has been engaged by the Municipality of Strathroy-Caradoc to undertake certain construction on Brennan Drive. This construction is scheduled to commence on or about Monday, July 11, 2022. See the attached figure showing the site location.

Our Company will take every reasonable precaution to minimize disruption, but you will appreciate that there must be some inconvenience during the course of the work.

The possibility of vibration due to compaction equipment during construction is not anticipated to be significant during this project. However, the potential for vibration does exist. Therefore, please make arrangements to protect your valuables that may be susceptible to damage due to vibration.

Residents and visitors should take precaution when driving around the construction site.

It is the responsibility of the property owners to remove any owner installed items within the road allowance such as sprinklers, landscape adornments, lamp post, etc. prior to commencement of construction.

Residents will be provided another notification letter confirming completion of the proposed watermain connection.

We recommend that all homeowners let all internal taps run for 5-10 minutes to flush the piping immediately after the new watermain connection has been completed.

As part of our Contract, our Company is assuming full responsibility for the construction work until it is entirely completed.
