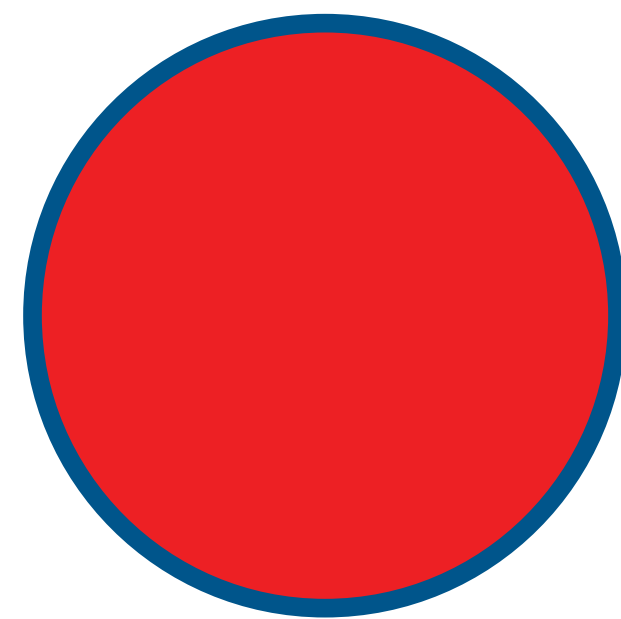

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

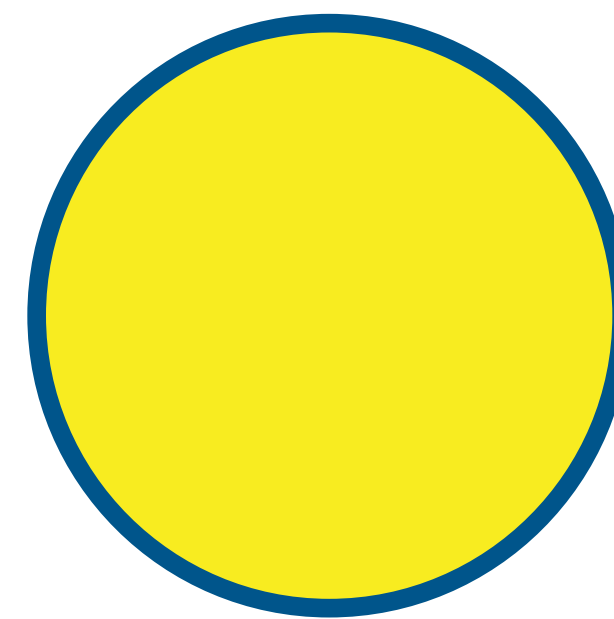
Your safety is our number one priority. We reserve the right to swim test any person at any time. For the safety of swimmers, Aquatic Park staff use a three-coloured wristband system to aid in applying our admission requirements:

6 Years & Under



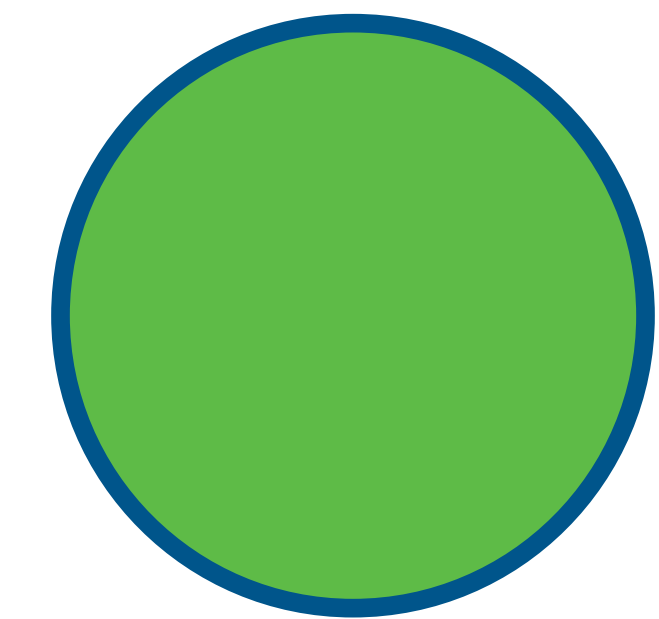
A red-banded child requires a guardian in order to be admitted to the pool

7-10 Years



A yellow-banded child needs to be swim-tested ASAP

11 Years & Older



A green-banded child may enter without a guardian

If the child cannot complete the swim test, they receive a red band

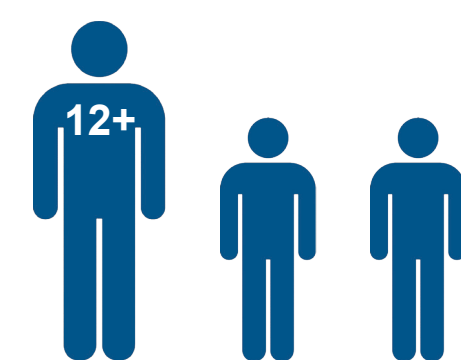
If the child successfully completes the swim test, they receive a green band

Guardian: Someone 12 years or older responsible for the direct supervision of a child.
Direct Supervision: Means being within arms reach of the child they are with.

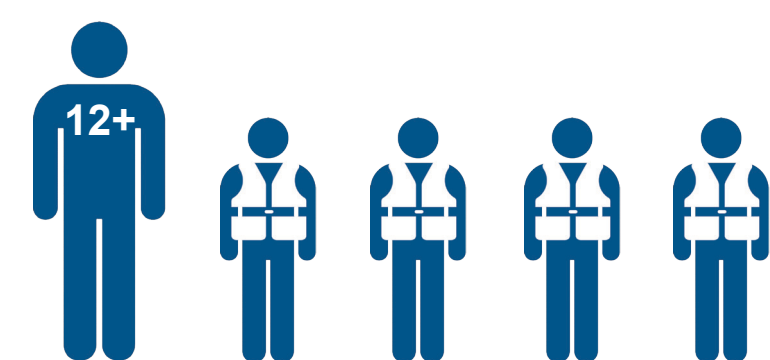
SUPERVISION RATIOS

For Children 6 Years & Under:

No Life jackets
1 Guardian: 2 children

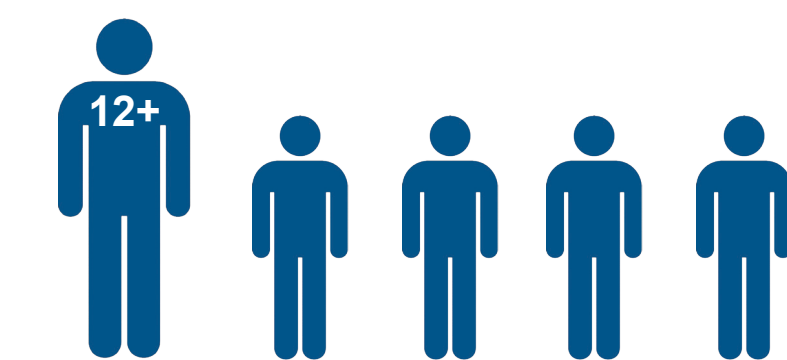


With Life jackets
1 Guardian: 4 children



For Children 7-10 Years:

Without Life jackets
1 Guardian: 4 children



With Life jackets
1 Guardian: 8 children



Please note that the coloured wristbands are to reflect whether a child needs to be SUPERVISED ONLY; a green wristband does not mean you may swim in the deep-end. You must take the swim test to be allowed in the deep-end. We reserve the right to administer deep-end tests to whom we see fit. **Children under 12 must be accompanied by a guardian. If a child is not a competent swimmer, a guardian must be prepared to enter the water with the child to ensure their safety.**
