Payment for summer day camps can be made by credit card online, over the phone, or in person, and by cash, cheque, debit or credit at the office. Payment plans available.

• What If I Need To Cancel?

Transfers can be made at no extra charge at any point prior to camp starting. (Difference in camp rates may apply)
All Cancellations are subject to a \$25 admin fee.

8 weeks before camp - The remainder will be refunded.

2-8 weeks before camp - Client can choose to have the remainder left as a credit on their account to be used within 1 calendar year or refund half of the total and have the other half on the account

Within 2 weeks before camp or during camp- No refund will be given
