



## Items Not Accepted:

- Bagged Household Waste (municipal curbside pickup only)
- Hazardous Materials (includes paints, Propane tanks, oil, pesticides, fluorescent bulbs, medications, pool chemicals, batteries, herbicides)
- Pressure Treated Lumber

**Note:** Empty paint and stain cans can be placed in your BRA recycling container. Cans still containing paint or stain can be brought to Home Hardware (28390 Centre Road) or Rona (28460 Centre Road).  
\*Subject to change. We advise residents to call ahead before visiting local retailers with their paint/stain cans.

## Items Accepted At No Charge:

- Scrap Metal
- Tires (with or without rim) **(Strathroy location only)**
- Yard Waste (leaves, grass clippings, garden waste, brush under 4' long and 3' in diameter) - if brought in plastic bags, it will need to be emptied into pile, paper bags can be thrown right on pile
- Cardboard only **(Strathroy location only)**
- Electronics & Appliances not containing freon (ensure all appliances are emptied of food and waste)

## Items Accepted With Tipping Fee:

- Building materials (drywall, non-pressure treated wood, concrete)
- Furniture, carpets, and mattresses (mattress cost depends on size)
- Appliances containing Freon
- Brush greater than 4' long and 3' in diameter
- Shingles and asphalt **(Strathroy location only)**
